Medical Surveillance Program

Alcohol Testing

The Department of Transportation has issued a rule, which provides for the random testing for the presence of alcohol in employees who operate a commercial motor vehicle. Employees shall be randomly selected by the Department of Energy using a statistically valid method. This program is established to ensure that employees who operate a commercial motor vehicle are not impaired by alcohol. The provisions of the alcohol-testing program apply to occupations and jobs, which require a Commercial Driver's License and are listed below.
